PSA 071658 JFC & Associates Amendment 02-Increase funding and

additional scope of work.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On September 7, 2023, the commission approved \$2.85 million to implement the NextGen Finance and Procurement Project, of which \$350,000.00 was allocated for integrations and modifications to existing Port systems. The NextGen Project is currently on schedule and within budget. The actions requested below fall within the already approved NextGen Project budget; no additional project funds are being sought.

Services to develop NextGen project integrations are being provided by multiple vendors with expertise in specific Port systems, including by JFC & Associates for the Port's Maximo application. JFC & Associates were selected, and PSA 071658 issued, through a competitively bid RFP in 2022. Available funds on PSA 071658 are insufficient to allow JFC & Associates to complete the NextGen project integration work, and additional funds of \$130,000.00 are to be added to PSA 071658 to allow the completion of this work.

#### **ACTIONS REQUESTED**

**PSA 071658** In accordance with Resolution No. 2023-03-PT, Section IV.E.4, staff is informing the Commissioners of the Port of its intent to increase the JFC contract funding over 50% of original amount, by adding **\$130,000.00** and adding additional scope of work for the NextGen Finance and Procurement Project.
