TOTAL MARINE AND INDUSTRIAL ECONOMIC IMPACT







The Port of Tacoma encompasses more than 2,700 acres used by both marine cargo and other industrial tenants. The Northwest Seaport Alliance (NWSA) manages containerized cargo at the Ports of Tacoma and Seattle, which together form one of the largest marine cargo gateways in the United States.

In 2023, Port of Tacoma and NWSA activities in Pierce County supported more than 41,000 jobs. These workers earned a combined \$3.4 billion in total compensation, and the businesses generated nearly \$10.8 billion in revenue.

JOBS BY THE NUMBERS

Direct jobs are related to Port operations and include longshore workers, truck drivers, railroad crew and freight forwarders.

Indirect jobs are created by Port-related spending on goods and services and include workers at office supply companies, maintenance and repair businesses, and parts and equipment suppliers.

Induced jobs are created when people directly employed by marine cargo operations spend their wages on housing, food and other consumer goods.
