Scope of Work: The work required for this project includes providing all labor, equipment and materials necessary to repair fender systems, pier structures and other marine systems when requested by the Engineer on Port property. The work will be assigned by Task Orders; each Task Order will address the scope of work and time of completion, and shall be performed in accordance with the Technical and Task Order Specifications.

Contract Amount: Contract amount is **Not to Exceed (NTE) \$600,000.00**, plus Washington State Sales Tax.

Sealed Bid Date/Time/Location: Bids will be received at the Reception Desk, Port Administration Office, **One Sitcum Plaza, Tacoma, Washington 98421** until **2:00 PM** on **June 17th, 2014** at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bid Bond: Each bid must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Security in an amount equal to five (5%) percent of the NTE contract amount (\$600,000.00).
